His vision is for a beautiful area where people can meet, enjoy peace, take wedding photos within the **eight** flower gardens and experience the Power of **Eight**.




Paul's thoughts...


Local Volunteers




Bird's Eye view

The diameter of the garden is 40 ft.

The fountain diameter is 20 ft.


Concept plans were developed by Gillian Tate, Florence Design Co.



Elevation plan



The fountain features two rocks, one granite and the other limestone, representing The Land Between. The 20 ft. retaining wall has a constant 2 in. level of water. The continuous flow of water over the two central rocks completes the fountain. The granite and limestone rocks are 3 ft. high sitting on a round 4 ft. high concrete pedestal.





The Garden Plants

Lou Loree, a former master gardener, has created six different designs to choose from for the **eight** gardens.

Each design features low maintenance perennial plants and each garden has its own automatic sprinkler system.

The selected design will produce a variety of plants giving a continuous show of splendour.




Ward Memorial Park

The Garden celebrates where granite meets limestone.





By the way, there are **eight** committee members!





Retired pastor Ross Fogwell is spearheading the history of The Land Between.


Four historical plaques will be placed inside the fountain visible to the visitors as they walk around the garden.


